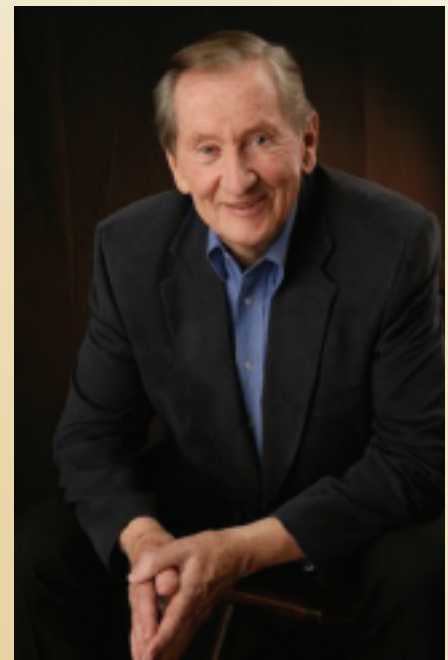


Meet Charley Green
