He does not believe in teaching horses to communicate in human terms, but rather to teach the human to communicate in terms the horse can understand — and therefore respond to. This brand of communication or "language" is one that transcends all of the varied riding disciplines. If you ride a horse, any horse, any breed, in any area of the sport these methods and this language will make you and your horse the best team you can be in any venue. It is work, it does take time, (more than 30 minutes for sure), but the end result is one that defies easy description. The "language" becomes the unspoken, the mutual trust and understanding a given, and the harmony of movement a bond between horse and rider.
