

Symphony Trail Press Release

Southeast Wabaunsee County will be the site for the upcoming Symphony Trail, trial ride, held on June 16, 2007. Jamie Schultz, of Crystal Springs Ranch will be leading a limited group of riders on a morning ride south of Lake Wabaunsee. The ride will cover some 1800 acres of land adjacent to the 2007 site for the Symphony in the Flint Hills. Tickets for that concert, which is later the same day are part of the package price. Also included in the package is a chuck-wagon meal complete with cowboy entertainment.

Tickets are limited to both the ride and the symphony. Symphony tickets and were sold out well in advance of the event last year, so getting you place reserved early is a plus. The ride will last approximately four hours and will end back where it started within a mile of the symphony site. Shuttles will be available from the trailer parking area to the symphony site for those who need transportation after the ride to finish out the day with the breathtaking Kansas City Symphony production.
