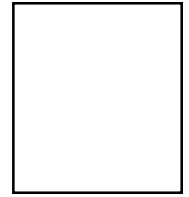

Follow I-70 to exit 313. Go south on Hwy. 177 for approximately 2 miles to Foote Ranch sign. There will be signs along the highway. Turn east on the gravel road through the pasture. The ride camp site will be approximately 1 mile east on the gravel road.
