

This is a confirmation of your registration for the Burlingame Saddle Club Fundraiser Trail Ride in the Flint Hills.

This is to confirm that we received \$ for number of riders. Money will only be refunded if the ride is completely cancelled.

You may check in anytime after 8:30 a.m. The trail ride will begin at 10:00 a.m.

Bring your own lunch and any drinks or snacks you want on the trail. Dinner is included in the \$20 fee. \$5 will be charged for dinner for any non riders. Evening meal will begin approximately at 5:30 p.m. after the trail ride.

We will be holding this trail ride rain or shine! So please come prepared!

In case of heavy rains, this trail ride will not be held in the actual pastures, but will still be in the Flint Hills on the minimum maintenance roads that go around this pasture. This would be done in order not to damage the pasture ground.

Directions to trail ride: Starting at the intersection of Highway 99 and Highway 31 (this is south of Eskridge, KS), go north on 99 to Sandpiper Rd., (app. 1 mile). Turn west (left).

Follow Sandpiper road (this is a good gravel road), after approximately 1 mile Sandpiper turns into Allen Rd, (do not turn at Allen LANE), continue on west (straight) 2 more miles where Allen Rd. turns south. Go approximately 1.4 miles to Locust Creek Rd. Look for signs or a greeter at the gate on the west (right) side of the road.

If you are starting from Eskridge, go south app. 4.8 miles from the center of town to Sandpiper Rd., turn west (right). Then follow directions above.

TRAIL RIDE RULES:

Stay behind the trail boss or leader.

No dogs on trail ride.

No stallions.

No firearms.

Stay in general area of main group and travel in same direction.

Watch out for wire on the ground.

PLEASE be very careful with smoking materials.

If you choose to run your horse, please be away from the immediate area of the main group of trail riders. Also be aware that flint rock can be sharp, so do so at your own risk.

Please carry out any trash that you carry in. Let's leave it as clean or cleaner than we found it.
